Shell moved to One Central Building in Dubai. In preparation for a return-to-work post-pandemic, they reduced their real estate, wanting a more agile workplace for their 150 members.

Several workshops with our client resulted in the design of a variety of work applications: assigned desks for their trading teams and many touchdown and collaboration areas for the rest of their team.

Following Shell WorkWell fit-out concept, the traders' workspaces offer height-adjustable desks that encourage people to change postures throughout the day. Dual monitors reduce eye strain. The workstations are complemented by acoustic partition screens for added comfort and privacy.

The Very task chair on wheels allows for mobility for collaboration in the workplace. Its intuitive lumbar support enhances comfort to enable performance for a variety of tasks.

Expansive windows allow natural light to fill the entire office, giving workers a mood-boosting connection to the outdoors.

Many touchdown and collaboration areas are offered to the teams to foster interaction and movement.

Space divisions - either with lounge furniture or biophilia - create visual anchors.

These rooms were designed for communication and comfort. They are equipped with Active Seating products which fit needs anywhere agile working and adaptable space concepts are prioritized.




Meet. Share. Collaborate.


