

Overview

When Headsquarter opened their second co_working space in Zurich, they wanted to define a new approach to the work patterns that emerged during the pandemic. Remote working turned into a way of life that isolates people from each other. Their vision of coworking is a tool to connect people in the digital age. Their purpose is to offer a modern working world with extraordinary design. They partnered with Studio Aisslinger to create a new brandscape. After their first co-working space opening, they had experience with joinery solutions, but these were not suitable for their other locations. Thus, Haworth adapted Aisslinger's design specifications to its ranges, and we created a solution for all areas at Talacker 41.



Open workspaces and closed offices offer choice to the users, while keeping an aesthetical consistency. Nia chairs are ideal for agile working as they require minimal adjustment.



In the entrance, Pip small side table is perfect for a laptop or notebook, and it is light enough to move around for casual encounters.




