



Fabric Cleaning Instructions*

No matter the application, fabrics treated with Alta are easy to clean and maintain. Alta imparts the highest repellency and stain release properties to your fabrics and greatly reduces the need for cleaning agents. Maintenance is as simple as 1, 2, 3.

1. Liquid spills:

- Don't wait.
- Blot liquid quickly and gently with a clean, dry, absorbent cloth.
- This should suffice, but if liquid remains, continue with gentle blotting.
- Gently remove any soil or debris from the surface.
- · No rinsing needed.

2. If any residual spot remains...

- Flush soiled area liberally with warm water.
- Blot with a clean, dry, absorbent cloth.
- Change blotting cloth surface frequently, until spot is gone.
- Avoid brushing which can spread the stain; repeat process until the spot has been removed.
- Final rinse with warm water and then blot with clean, dry absorbent cloth, if needed.
- It is OK to use a water extraction machine if desired (follow directions on machine).

3. For difficult or stubborn stains that do not come out with Steps 1 or 2:

- Mix 2-3 drops of any kind of mild laundry detergent with 1 cup of water.
- Apply to the soiled area.
- Gently work the solution into the area, wait several seconds and blot the spot with a clean, dry, absorbent cloth. Repeat until spot has been completely removed.
- Rinse thoroughly with warm water and blot to remove any soap residue.
- Any remaining soap not rinsed away in the fabric can cause a recurring stain.
